high-quality program videos which provides smooth playback. Students on campus can also view YouTube videos, accurate weather forecasts, and up-to-the-minute Twitter feeds featuring campus events. Instead of using posters or flyers, the college campus often displays upcoming events on their screen using a ticker.

Impact: Digital signage has been extremely successful on campus and is leading the way for future possibilities. Many upcoming events that were placed on posters and flyers are now being replaced with digital signage, making it cost-effective to use. The cosmetology school on campus wants to eventually utilize one of the displays for their upcoming show, providing stunning graphics which depict their work.

Vance-Granville Community College also wants to use a touch screen solution. Hargrove stated, "We are looking forward to setting up a touch-screen kiosk on our campus for orientation registration and to display the campus map."
